DAVID LAWRENCE CENTER ADDS FULL TIME ACUTE CARE PSYCHIATRIST

Naples, FL – David Lawrence Center, Collier County’s only not-for-profit community mental health and substance abuse treatment center, is pleased to announce that Michael A. Corbin, M.D. has joined the Medical Team as a new full-time, board certified Adult Staff Psychiatrist in the Acute Care Services Department. In this capacity, he will provide psychiatric medical services to the Emergency Services Assessment Center, Adult Detoxification Unit and the Adult and Children’s Crisis Stabilization Unit, which serves as the Collier County Baker Act Receiving Facility.

Dr. Corbin earned a bachelor’s of arts degree in biology from University of Tennessee. He earned his medical degree from East Tennessee State University and his residency in psychiatry from Baylor College of Medicine. He is also a diplomat of the American Board of Psychiatry and Neurology.

Since 2004, Dr. Corbin has provided psychiatric medical services at David Lawrence Center and a variety of other treatment centers throughout Florida and Tennessee through Locum Tenens Agencies. In addition, he has had a private practice serving individuals and couples in Ft. Lauderdale since 2003. He has over 10 years of experience working in adult acute care units and working with individuals with severe and persistent mental illnesses using an assertive community treatment team model.

David Lawrence Center Medical Director Brent Lovett, M.D. states, “We are very excited to welcome Dr. Corbin to the David Lawrence Center Medical Team. His vast experience working with individuals and families in acute psychiatric crises makes him an excellent addition to the Acute Care Department where demand has grown tremendously over the last several years.
